Confirmation is an integral part of an individual's life and the church. When a young person is confirmed, they proclaim faith publicly. "Confirmation is the continuation of one's faith journey and the beginning of one's covenant relationship with the church – not an end unto itself" (*Credo*)

Beginning February 26, and continuing through May 14, the Sunday morning "youth small group" curriculum will be dedicated to confirmation preparation. Topics include the Bible, the Apostles Creed, the Church and the United Methodist Church, worship and sacraments, and spiritual disciplines. A break is scheduled for Easter and the Sunday after Easter. Confirmation Sunday is scheduled for May 21.

All youth in sixth grade and older, whether intending to be confirmed at Summit church or not, are invited to participate in this Sunday morning small group from 10:30 to 11:30. We hope you can attend. We will meet in the Youth Room downstairs and at the end of the hallway to the right of the stairs. I look forward to working with your youth as we begin this confirmation journey and grow in our faith together. Please let the church office know by February 19th if you plan to participate.
