Sunday 9:30 AM Worship (November 26 through December 17)

Who are the people God used to change our relationship with Him? Advent is about God. The Christmas story unfolded through unlikely people. First it was an older couple, Zechariah and Elizabeth, then a younger couple, Joseph and Mary. Finally, the shepherds also played an essential part in God's incarnation story. We probably have more in common with these individuals than most people in the Bible and more than we realize. On Sunday mornings during this season of Advent and Christmas Eve, we explore each of these men and women and how our stories align with theirs. More importantly, just like theirs, our story is part of God's story.

Advent Worship Experience - Wednesday at 7 PM (November 29, December 6, 13, 20) Do you hear God's voice? We explore the spiritual principles that allow us to listen to God and discover our purpose to make a difference in the world. In week one, we explore the barriers that prevent us from hearing or sensing God. In week two, some steps help us to be more open to God's voice. Then, in week three, we discover how God calls us through our passions. Finally, in week four, we see how hearing God is accomplished in the context of community and others on the same journey. Let Advent make us better listeners to God. Let that inspire you to follow God's purposes.
