Roger moved to Pittsburgh in 2013 after serving United Methodist congregations in North Carolina for ten years. He is currently the Co-Senior Pastor, with his wife, Ginger Thomas, of Fox Chapel Presbyterian Church outside of Pittsburgh. He is the author of several books, including Everyday Contemplative: The Way of Prayerful Living and What We Need Is Here: Practicing the Heart of Christian Spirituality.
